ABOUT PUREHEAT GARAGE & PATIO

Thank you for your purchase of pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO. This heater provides consistent warmth to outdoor spaces using carbon infrared heating technology, warming your friends and family directly instead of just heating the surrounding air.

pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO can be mounted using easy-to-install bracket, or it can be placed on an adjustable metal stand for mobility. Either way, the silent and odorless heating element is a safe distance from children and pets.

For optimum comfort, three different levels of heat can be produced with almost no warm-up time. A 24-hour timer allows for specific shut-off time selection, and all features can be adjusted using the included remote control. pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO is durable, lightweight, maintenance-free, and can connect to your standard household electrical outlet.




UNIT DIAGRAM



IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using this heater.
- This heater is not when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. If
 provided, use handles when moving this heater. Keep combustible materials, such as
 furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes, and curtains at least 3 feet (0.9 m) from the
 front of the heater and keep them away from the sides and rear.
- Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used by or near children or invalids and whenever the heater is left operating and unattended.
- Always unplug heater when not in use. (This item may be omitted if the heater is
 provided with a clock-operated switch).
- Do not operate any heater with a damaged cord or plug or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Discard heater, or return to authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- This heater is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas and similar indoor locations. Never locate heater where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Do not route cord under furniture or appliances. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
- To disconnect heater, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.
- Connect to properly grounded outlets only.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this
 may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater.
- To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use
 on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
- A heater has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. Do not use it in areas where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored.
- Use this heater only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Always plug heaters directly into a wall outlet/receptacle. Never use with an extension cord or relocatable power tap (outlet/power strip).
- SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS
- This heater is for use on 120 volts. The cord has a plug as shown at (A) in the figure below.
 An adapter as shown at C is available for connecting three-blade grounding-type plugs
 to two-slot receptacles. The green grounding lug extending from the adapter must
 be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box. The
 adapter should not be used if a three-slot grounded receptacle is available.




UNIT SETUP - Floor Stand




INSPECT THE UNIT FOR DAMAGE BEFORE SETUP OR USE.

 Begin by connecting the Bottom Post (Post with a Flat Base) to the Base, using the provided Four (4) M6*30 Screws.




 Slide the Base Cover over the connected post to cover the screws and then slide One (1) Large Cord Clip over the post.



 Place the Middle Post (Optional for extra 17.5" height) onto the Bottom Post and fasten them together using Three (3) M5*6 Screws on the sides. Slide the remaining (1) Large Cord Clip over the post.



4. Place the Large and Small Cord Clips on the Top Post then place the Post onto the Middle Post (or Bottom Post if you want a lower height) and fasten them together using Three (3) M5*6 Screws on the sides.



UNIT SETUP - Floor Stand

Use Two (2) M6*14 Bolts and Two (2)
 Acorn Nuts to combine Top of Bracket
 1 (Long End) to the Bottom of Bracket 2
 (Short End) .



 Use Two (2) M6*35 Screws and Two
 (2) Wing Nuts to install the Front of Bracket 2 (Long End) to the rear of the Telescoping Post.




 Use Two (2) M5*12 Screws to install Bracket 1 (Short End) to the rear of the Heater Body.



8. Use the Two (2) remaining M5*12 Screws to mount the Grille Guard to the rear of the Heater Body. The Grill Guard should extend over the front of the unit.



 Loosen the Telescoping Lock and slide the pole and unit up or down to your desired height, then re-tighten the Telescoping Lock.

HEATER MUST BE MOUNTED HORIZONTALLY OR THE TIP OVER SAFETY SWITCH WILL ENGAGE AND THE UNIT WILL NOT OPERATE.


- Ensure the desired mounting location can fit the unit in a horizontal orientation and is near an outlet but free from electrical cables, communication lines, and pipes that could be damaged by excessive heat.
- If needed, pre-drill your wall and insert
 Wall Anchors. Use Bracket 2 as a template for hole placement.




Use Two (2) M6*14 Bolts and Two (2) Acorn
 Nuts to combine Top of Bracket 1 (Long
 End) to the Bottom of Bracket 2 (Short End) .



 Use (3) ST4*35 Screws and fasten the Mounting Bracket to the Wall in a vertical orientation. Use the top hole and the outside holes on the bottom.




 Use Two (2) M5*12 Screws to install the Mounting Bracket to the rear of the Heater Body.

USING PUREHEAT GARAGE & PATIO

Power

pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO starts in Standby Mode when first turned on. The unit has power but is not actively heating.



To turn the unit on, toggle the Power Switch to " - ".

Modes

Changing the Power Mode increases the Heat Output.

P1 is the Lowest Heat Output Mode and P3 is the Maximum Heat Output Mode.

- P1 Press the Mode Button once to change to Power Mode 1(500W).
- Press the Mode Button again to change to Power Mode 2 (1000W).
- P73 Press the Mode Button a third time to change to Power Mode 3 (1500W).

Pressing the Mode Button once more puts the unit in Standby Mode again.

Timer

While the unit is active, a timer can be set to turn the unit OFF after a desired amount of hours.

Press the Timer Button to change the amount of hours before the unit will shut off. The time will increase in 1 Hour Increments, up to 24 Hours.

MAINTENANCE

CLEANING



TURN PUREHEAT GARAGE & PATIO OFF AND DISCONNECT FROM THE OUTLET BEFORE CLEANING.

To extend the life of your pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO, perform regular cleanings with a damp cloth. Do not disassemble the unit; clean only the exterior.

STORAGE

To prevent accidents, or save some space, store your pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO in a cool, dry place. Perform a cleaning and allow it to dry before packing it away.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Unit Fails to Turn On

First, check to ensure your unit is plugged in and the power switch on the rear is in the "on" position. If these have already been checked, your Tip-Over Safety Switch may be stuck. Tilt the unit 90° to the side and then back into a standing position. Set your heat level to P3 to make sure it is working.

LIMITED WARRANTY INFORMATION

Your pureHeat GARAGE & PATIO (Product) is warranted to be free from all defects in material and workmanship in normal household use for a period of **3 Years** from date of purchase. The warranty is granted only to the original purchaser. The warranty is subject to the following provisions:

Any damages or malfunctions caused by negligence, abuse, or use not in accordance with the Product Owner's Manual are not covered by this warranty. Likewise, any defects or damages caused by unauthorized service or the use of other than Genuine pureHeat Parts are not covered.

All shipping charges are the responsibility of the purchaser. GreenTech Environmental will, at its option, repair or replace a defective Product or part(s) for the Product that is/are covered by this warranty.

As a matter of warranty policy, GreenTech Environmental will not refund the customer's purchase price.

OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE

To obtain warranty service you must return the defective product along with proof of purchase to the pureHeat Authorized Service Center. All shipping costs submitted under this Warranty shall be borne by purchaser. Unless this Warranty is expressly renewed or extended by pureHeat, any repaired or replaced part of unit shall be warranted to the original purchaser only for the length of the unexpired portion of the original warranty.
